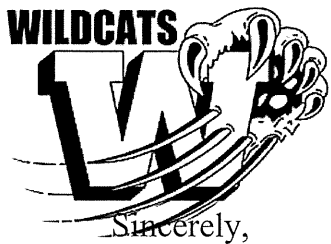


- 2nd Grade IREAD-3
