  - Mr. Davis will provide updates and information on Summer School at WES.

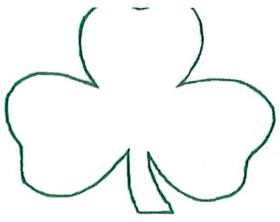
