North Liberty Elementary Board Recognitions for September 16, 2025

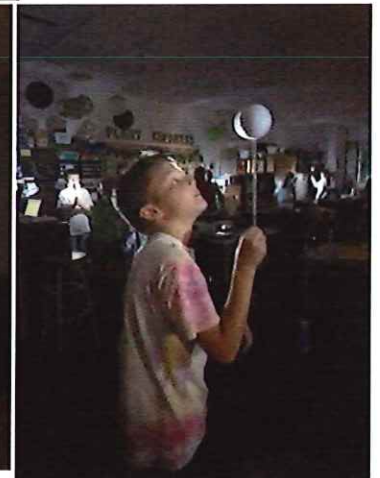
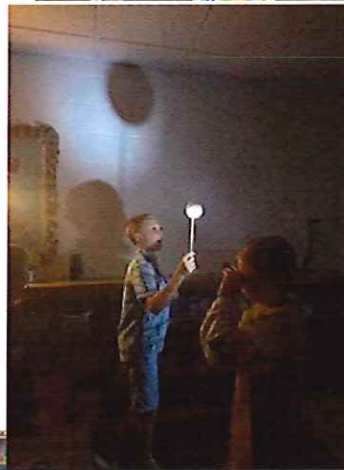
Recognitions:
