School Board Meeting – May 21, 2013 Regular Session

CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL - 7:00 P.M.

ESTABLISH A QUORUM AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Board of School Trustees of the John Glenn School Corporation met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. on May 21, 2013, at the John Glenn Administration Building. Board members present were Jeff Johnson, Dennis Holland, Janice Ryan, Curt Pletcher, Bill Groves, Tom McCormick and Bob Borlik. Richard Reese, Superintendent, and 6 observers were also present. After the Pledge of Allegiance, President Dennis Holland asked for a moment of silence to honor the families and victims of the recent Oklahoma tornadoes.
