# **NEW BUSINESS**

#### 1. Bob Aloi, Territorial Engineering – Completed Construction Report

Mr. Bob Aloi, from Territorial Engineering, was present to announce that the soccer field construction is completed, with only a few minor issues that will be corrected in the fall. A short discussion was held to review information and answer questions from the Board.

# 2. Approve Resolution to Reduce Appropriation

Mr. Tom Bendy, Treasurer, presented information asking for board approval to reduce the Exempt Debt Service Fund by \$216,000 in the 2016 Budget. An over-allocation was made previously and the resolution will allow a correction to be made. Curt Pletcher made a motion to approve the resolution to reduce the Exempt Debt Service Fund Appropriation by \$216,000. Bill Groves seconded the motion, and the motion passed with a vote of six to zero.

# 3. Approve Text Book Rental Fees for the 2016-2017 School Year

Mr. Reese noted that most of the elementary fees are either the same as last year, or have dropped from last year. The only exception to this is Fourth Grade (+ \$4) and Sixth Grade (+ \$10). Urey Middle School Fees remain the same as last year: high school fees are dependent upon classes taken. Bill Groves made a motion to approve the 2016-2017 Textbook Rental Fees, and Dennis Holland seconded the motion. The motion passed with a vote of six to zero.

#### 4. Approve Increase to Adult Breakfast Price

Mrs. Celeste Dooms requested an increase in price to the adult breakfast rate as it was discovered that the previous price was not in compliance with the Federal Government formula. Dennis Holland made a motion to approve the adult breakfast price increase to \$1.75, and Bill Groves seconded the motion. The motion passed with a vote of six to zero.
