

School Board Meeting – June 4, 2019

Regular Session

CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL – 7:00 P.M.

ESTABLISH A QUORUM AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Board of School Trustees of the John Glenn School Corporation met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. on June 4, 2019, at the John Glenn Administration Office. Richard Reese, Superintendent, and seven observers were also present.

Mr. Reese next announced that Mr. Branson Hiatt will be donating \$100,000 to the John Glenn Education Foundation to be used for scholarships. Details are still being worked out and an official announcement will be made later.

Mr. Reese recognized Marie Fansler, Transportation Director, for her outstanding efforts on arranging Summer School bus routes.

Mr. Reese notified board members that he recently met with employees of Umbaugh and Ice Miller to discuss a G.O. Bond. This bond will be approximately \$1.5 million. More details will be provided to the board at the next meeting.
