## **Law, Public Safety, Corrections and Security:**

**Includes the \$350 billion U.S. security market.**

**Is projected to be the 4th-fastest growing Career Cluster.**

**Will employ more than 3 million in protective services by 2020.**

**The law and security sector has a high share of jobs for individuals with some postsecondary education or an associate degree, and these workers can earn well above the median wage.**

**By 2018, more than 80 percent of jobs in this sector will necessitate at least some postsecondary education, with 40 percent open to those with more than a high school diploma but less than a bachelor's degree.**

# The Law, Public Safety & Corrections Career Pathways

There are 5 Career Pathways in this cluster:

- **Correction Services** – Corrections Officer, Case Manager, Counselor, Warden
- **Emergency and Fire Management Services** – Fire Fighter, HazMat Specialist, EMT
- **Security and Protective Services** – Security Systems Installer, Guard, Security Trainer
- **Law Enforcement Services** – Police Officer, Bomb Technician, Investigator, Detective
- **Legal Services** – Attorney, Court Reporter, Legal Secretary, Paralegal, Mediator.
